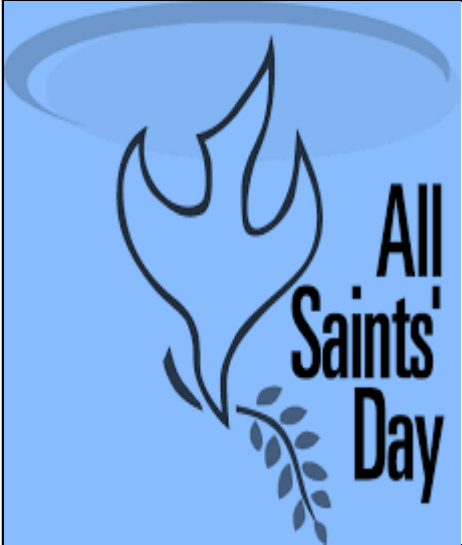

# From the desk of Fr. Boniface

My Dear Parishioners,

The feast of All Saints is a holy day on which the church glorifies God for all his saints, known and unknown. On this day we remember the saints, who may have been forgotten, or never been specifically honored. But they are holy persons whose examples we aim to follow and their life we imitate and at the same time ask for their prayers and intercessions. The whole concept of All Saints Day is tied in with the concept of the Communion of Saints.
