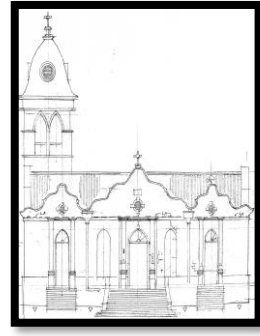

From the desk of Fr. Boniface

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the 4th Sunday of Easter and it is commonly known as "Good Shepherd Sunday," a day in which the Church recalls the relationship between God and His people as described in the image of Shepherd and Sheep. Each year, the Gospel Reading of today is chosen from Chapter 10 of St. John's Gospel, where Jesus speaks of himself as the "Good Shepherd." In recent times, this day has also become known as "World day of Prayer for Vocations" a day set aside to fulfill the Lord's instruction to 'pray the Lord of the harvest to send the laborers into his harvest'. (Mt 9:38). It is obvious that our Church today is in great need of good shepherds, totally committed to the Way of Jesus. For this reason, we are invited today to reflect on the meaning of God's call and to pray for good vocations. Those called to ministry in whatever capacity in the Church are like shepherds. They are called to care for the spiritual welfare of those they serve.

Jesus is obviously our Good Shepherd, there is no doubt about it but there can be a lot of doubt about whether we are the kind of sheep that we ought to be. As we celebrate Good Shepherd Sunday, let us pray to the Lord that we may be his good sheep, listening attentively to his voice, and follow his example of self-giving love. Let us also pray for all our shepherds, especially our religious and political leaders that they may follow the example of Jesus who was willing to serve and lay down his life for his sheep. Jesus our Good Shepherd is the Way, Truth and Life. He is the one who goes after the lost sheep leaving the ninety-nine to bring it back to the fold.
