Holy Mass on Sunday Afternoons

During the last Parish Pastoral Council Meeting on July 6th, 2022, we agreed to begin the Sunday afternoon Holy Mass at St. Patrick Church at 5:00 PM. This Holy Mass is meant to help those who are unable to come for the 8:30 AM Holy Mass in the morning, to have the opportunity to fulfil their Sunday obligations. We call on the young people to take note of this Holy Mass and be in attendance. Also being the only Holy Mass on Sundays in the afternoon, It is our expectation that persons from the other parishes on the Island will take advantage of this opportunity to fulfil their Sunday obligation. This Holy Mass at St. Patrick Church on Sunday Afternoons shall begin on Sunday, August 14th, 2022.

Change of Mass Time for Sunday Vigil Mass & Weekdays

The Parish Pastoral Council also discussed and agreed that the Sunday Vigil Mass on Saturdays should begin at 5:00 PM as the Sunday afternoon Masses, so that the Holy Mass would not stretch too much into the night.

To give the opportunity for those who go to work to attend Holy Mass during the week, especially the Priests and Religious who will be involved in the teaching at the school, the time for weekly Holy Mass will begin at 7:00 AM. The date and time of these changes are as follows:

Sunday, Vigil Mass Saturday, August 13, 2022 – 5:00PM

Sunday Afternoon Holy Mass. August, 14, 2022- 5:00PM

Weekly Daily Holy Mass, August 15, 2022 – 7:00AM

Saturday Morning Holy Mass, August 20, 2022 -7:00AM
