# From the desk of Fr. Boniface

My dear parishioners:

Let us think back to the first century especially fifty years after Jesus' death and what His disciples had done that brought billions of people into the ranks of the church up to today. They suffered because they want to accomplish the mission of making disciples of all nations. We like the outcome of their discipleship but we don't want to hear the cost of discipleship. So, for the record here is the cost that history tells us:

John died of extreme old age exiled to the island of Patmos; Judas Iscariot, after betraying his Lord, hanged himself; Peter was crucified, head downward, during the persecution of Nero; Andrew died on a cross at Patrae, a Grecian Colony; James, the younger, son of Alphaeus, was thrown from a pinnacle of the Temple, and then beaten to death with a club; Bartholomew was flayed alive in Albanapolis, Armenia; James, the elder son of Zebedee, was beheaded at Jerusalem; Thomas, the doubter, was run through the body with a lance at Coromandel, in the East Indies; Philip was hanged against a pillar at Heropolis; Thaddeus was shot to death with arrows; Simon died on a cross in Persia (what we now call Iran.); Matthew was first stoned and then beheaded.

What a sacrifice on the part of the apostles. In turn, what sacrifice have you done for the sake of God? What have you given up for the Lord? Finally, how about learning these three lessons from today's Gospel? 1) Sacrifice is a sign of mature commitment; 2) Hospitality is a sign of discipleship; and 3) A cup of water is a sign that Christ is welcome. . Sunday to you all!
