From the desk of Fr. Honitace

My Dear Parishioners

In today's Gospel we have the parable of the vineyard and the wicked tenants. The purpose of the parable is as we find it in the gospel of Matthew to show that the death of Jesus at the hands of his opponents is consistent with the way God's messengers have been treated down the centuries. They were given a vineyard to cultivate but they claimed it as their own and refused not only to give any return to the true owner but murdered his own son who had come to them on behalf of his father. The Jews had totally failed in their task to prepare for the Messiah but instead they not only refused to listen to him, but chose to destroy him. The killing of the son "outside the city" is a clear reference to Jesus dying on the cross outside the walls of Jerusalem.

Today, we are God's chosen people. We are the tenants in the vineyard. Now, God calls us to produce the fruits of the Kingdom of God that will endure. How do we see this call? Do we find ourselves specially privileged, by baptism, to be called to work in the Lord's vineyard? How well, have we received the message of the Lord, when time and again we are invited to gather together to hear the Gospel and to make it part of our lives?

The Gospel concludes with the words that the Kingdom of God will be given to a people that produce the fruits of the Kingdom. God values faithful stewardship. Since stewardship is an exercise in responsibility, it follows that God puts premium on our sense of responsibility. We are responsible for our life and for everything else that the Father has entrusted to us in this life. Let us today pray for the wisdom and the courage never to abuse our privileges but rather to make a good use of all the privileges and opportunities that God gives us. Blessed Sunday to you all!
